



CLUB INDIVIDUALIZED WORKOUT PROTOCOL

PHASE

Youth sports and other types of physical activity for children may resume provided that participants can social distance at all times during activities (i.e., no contact between participants and/or coaches) and no competitions held during Phase 1.





GROUP SIZE

Group classes are limited to 10 participants per group, and multiple groups may run per session so long as social distancing can be maintained.

SANITATION

Program coordinators will make hand sanitizer or hand washing stations readily available for all employees and participants.


FACE MASK POLICY

Coaches and staff must wear cloth face coverings.

Face masks are voluntary for participating athletes.



GENERAL GUIDELINES



- Players will be reminded to Use Restroom prior to ARRIVAL. (Restrooms available for emergency use only)
- Athletes must bring
- -CLEAN attire
- -Water/hydration
 (Water Stations will not be available)
- The day of tryouts <u>all athletes</u> are to complete Standardized Screen Assessment (SSA) to participate in Practice.

(SSA will be sent by program director to participants)

• EACH PARTICIPANT MUST HAVE A SIGNED WAIVER PRIOR TO PRACTICE

(waiver will be sent by program director to participants)

• Follow drop off directions and go directly to check in





DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS

- Players will check in at the registration table
- We will confirm that the waiver and standard screening assessment has been completed
- Player may not remove face mask until the arrive in their assigned area



PLAYER ARRIVAL

- The field will be setup, with all equipment (Balls, cones, etc.) prior to the arrival of each individual athlete to limit contact with equipment and ensure proper sanitization.
- Individual Player equipment allotments will be organized by equipment staff and stored on site. CONTINUED ADHERENCE TO SANITIZATION PROTOCOLS WILL BE FOLLOWED.
- Players will prepare and get dressed at their cars



PARENT EXPECTATIONS

- PARENTS ARE TO SPECTATE OUTSIDE THE FIELD FENCE
- NO parents are allowed inside the building
- NO parents are allowed inside fenced area of outdoor field
- All social distancing guidelines must be met
- We ask parents to meet their kids at your car post session (Staff will control traffic and organize player exiting)

POST SESSION



- Player completes session and leaves all equipment inside their designated grid
- Designated Equipment/Essential staff will wipe down all equipment used (cones, balls etc.) and re-setup as needed
- Only 1 Individual is allowed at the sanitation stations at a time
- Players will move directly to the player exit while maintaining social distancing practices, and must follow the exit procedure given by the program director
